

Children's Medical Fee Aid System

Any child with an address in Izumo City, who is either insured by health insurance or a dependent, is eligible.

- Please present your My Number Card or another health insurance-confirming document as well as the Certificate of Eligibility for Children's Medical Fee Aid at the medical institutions and pharmacies you use.
 - The Certificate of Eligibility for Children's Medical Fee Aid can be used at medical facilities and pharmacies within Shimane prefecture, but your Izumo City Health Insurance Card will not be recognized in other prefectures, with the exception of certain facilities. You can still receive medical care in other prefectures, but you may have to pay the full amount out of your own pocket. When you return to Shimane, please apply for reimbursement at a later date to recover any medical fees incurred that are covered by your insurance card.
- × You cannot use the Certificate of Eligibility for Children's Medical Fee Aid issued by Izumo City after moving out of the city. If you present the certificate and receive treatment after moving out, you will be required to return the amount of aid you received.

At a service counter: Izumo City Hall Child Policies Division or Each Administrative Center's Citizen Services Division (Necessary items: **A document confirming the child's health insurance information** & Certificate of Eligibility for Children's Medical Aid (not necessary if lost))

《**Reimbursement**》 If you paid 20 or 30% of the expenses at a medical institution, you can apply for reimbursement. Online applications are available *Application period: within 2 years from the date the invoice was received.

4. Integration of My Number Card and Certificate of Eligibility for Children's Medical Fee Aid

Some medical institutions in Izumo City are able to confirm your Certificate of Eligibility via your My Number Card.

5. High-Cost Medical Care

◇If the 20-30% self-payment is high-cost, the amount above the upper limit of self-payment may be reimbursed by your health insurance company. The city can help individuals pay for the self-payment of medical care through Children's Medical Fee Aid. The city will ask for authorization from the insured individual and receive reimbursement for high-cost medical care from the insurance company. To receive the reimbursement, the city will send you a letter of proxy. Please fill in and stamp this document. ◇ If you have already been reimbursed by the insurance company, you will be required to return that reimbursement to the city. To confirm the amount to be returned, please submit a copy of the settlement notice of high-cost medical care issued by the insurance company.

There is no need to do this procedure if you are using My Number health insurance card. Please be sure to present your My Number Card at the counter. Medical expenses are calculated on a monthly basis, so you must present your card every time you visit.

6. 16 Diseases (e.g. Chronic Respiratory Disease)

When a person who is under 20 years of age and is not covered by the Children's Medical Free Aid System is hospitalized due to a group of 16 diseases such as chronic respiratory disease, medical expenses will be reimbursed 15,000 yen/month (hospital).

16 diseases such as chronic respiratory diseases ① Malignant neoplasms (cancers) ② Chronic kidney disease ③ Chronic respiratory diseases ④ Chronic cardiac disease ⑤ Endocrine disease ⑥ Collagen disease ⑦ Diabetes ⑧ Congenital metabolic disorder ⑨ Neuromuscular diseases ⑩ Chronic digestive disease ⑪ Blood diseases ⑫ Immune disorders ⑬ Chromosomal and genetic syndromes ⑭ Skin disorders ⑮ Skeletal dysplasia ⑯ Vascular disease

The Izumo Health Center is responsible for determining if your child's disease falls into one of the 16 categories above.
