

## How to Apply for a COVID-19 Vaccine Passport (Vaccination Certificate of COVID-19)

### ●Who can receive a vaccine passport/vaccination certificate?

·People who were vaccinated using a vaccine voucher issued by Izumo City.

### ●Fees

·Free of charge (however, if receiving the passport by mail, the applicant must pay postage costs).

### **If Applying by Mail**

●Submit the following documents by mail to the address on the right.

### **1. Application Form for Vaccination Certificate of COVID-19**

Download the form via [this link](#), or pick up a copy from the Health Services Division service counter.

### **2. Copy of Passport**

※Copy the page with the applicant's photo and passport number

### **3. Copy of Completed Vaccination Voucher OR Copy of Record of Vaccination**

If you had a Vaccination Voucher at the time of your vaccine, submit a copy of your Vaccination Voucher, including the bottom left section.

If you were vaccinated as a healthcare worker or through your employer before receiving a Vaccination Voucher from the city, submit a copy of your Record of Vaccination.

### **4. Copy of Identification Document (front and back; must contain address)**

Residence card (*zairyū kādo*), driver's license, health insurance card, passport, etc.

### **5. Reply Envelope, 23.5cm x 12cm**

Please write your name and address and affix an 84-yen stamp.

### **6. Power of Attorney form (if submitting an application by proxy)**

Download the form via [this link](#).

Paper forms are available at the Health Services Division service counter.

### ●Issuance Method

The document will be sent to you by mail using your reply envelope.

※Please be sure to provide a reply envelope with your application.

### ●Caution

The city may contact you if your application documents are incomplete. Please write your contact information (such as a cellphone number where you can be easily reached) on the application.
