

Izumo City Special Benefit to Support Parenting Expenses "Hagukumi"

Izumo City is providing financial aid to families with children, as the cost of food and other necessities has gone up, impacting many families.

1. Eligible Children

Children born between April 2, 2005 and April 1, 2024.

2. Who can apply?

Guardians who are the primary provider in the household, with child(ren) born within the date range above and for whom either ① or ② is true. There are no limitations on the applicant's income.

- (1) Is a registered resident of Izumo City with an eligible dependant child as of January 31, 2024.
- January 31, 2024.
 (2) Has a child dependant who was born between February 1, 2024 and April 1, 2024, and that child was registered as a resident of Izumo City at the time of their birth.
 - X Primary provider in the household: the person who is responsible for the majority of the child's living costs etc.

3. Amount

A flat payment of 10,000 yen per child. (Payment provided once per child.)

4. What's the process?

Written applications may or may not be required, depending on your circumstances.

①Who does not need to apply?

Anyone who is receiving child allowance from Izumo City does not need to apply. This payment will be automatically deposited into the account that is receiving child allowance payments.

- ※ If you do not wish to receive this payment, you will need to submit a Refusal of Receipt of Payment (jukyū kyohi todokede sho).
- ② Who needs to apply?

If you are not receiving child allowance from Izumo City for any of the reasons described in the example below, you need to apply.

- < Example >
- · My children are all between the ages of 16 and 18.
- My income is too high to receive child allowance.
- · I'm a public servant and receiving child allowance from my workplace.

If any of these sound like you, you need to apply!

5. Payment Date & Application Deadline

①If you do not need to apply:

The payment will be made on February 29, 2024. Depending on the circumstances of your child allowance payments, it may also be made on March 29. If you cannot confirm that the payment was made successfully, please contact us.

②If you need to apply:

Application Deadline: April 30, 2024 (Tuesday)

Depending on the date you apply, eligible applicants will have the payment made directly to their designated bank accounts at the end of April or May, 2024.

- Eligible applications made before March 31, 2024 will be paid at the end of April.
- Eligibility for applications made between April 1 and April 31, 2024 will be paid at the end of May.

6. How do I apply?

Please follow one of the three processes described below.

In order to apply, you will need the main provider's ID (Residence Card, etc.) and their bank account information (bankbook, cash card, etc.). If you are living separately from your children, you may need to provide extra documentation for the purpose of reviewing your application. If you have entered information incorrectly, your application was incomplete, or you fail to provide the correct documentation, you will not receive the benefit. Please check your application carefully prior to submission.



①Online applications are accepted until March 31, 2024.

(Application form is provided in Japanese only.)

Please access the application form and enter all required information. Attach any required documents as image files. If you have registered your bank account through your My Number, you do not need to provide any documentation related to that account.
