Right to Development

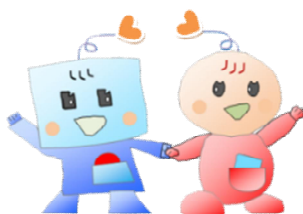
The right to learn, rest, play, etc.
